DTZ and GODFREY VAUGHAN have won one of the most prestigious instructions in the West End after being appointed on all of The Portman Estate's lettings.

DTZ is new to the instruction, while Godfrey Vaughan has always done the work on its own until now, but had to repitch as part of the process.

The new property director Mark Boor joined from Hammerson late last year. He is overseeing a big programme of refurbishing many of the period buildings on the estate, and there are five small office refurbishments under way on Gloucester Place
